Texas 4-H Congress

July 23 - 30

Texas 4-H Congress allows 4-H members to experience the law making process first hand by writing, submitting, and then serving as a member of the House of Representatives, the Senate, the Press, or as a Lobbyist. From these roles, the 4-H members determine the fate of each bill submitted.

State 4-H Horse Show

July 23—July 30

Competitors must qualify through their district in order to compete at this event. You can compete in events like western pleasure, working cowhorse, hunter under saddle, and barrel racing, to name a few. The State 4-H horse show is held each summer.
