The shooting sports project is one of the largest projects for Texas 4-H and participants not only learn firearm safety and responsible use, but build character while being mentally and physically challenged.

This is another huge disappointment for us to have to deliver to our members and families, but because of the guidance by local county health and elected officials, this is the best decision at this time due to the spike in COVID-19 cases statewide.
